ADMISSIONS POLICY

The school will be required to admit a child with a statement of Special Educational Needs if the statement names the school before the following criteria are applied:

1. Looked after Children (Children in the care of the Local Authority).
2. Children living in the catchment area, with an older sibling at the school at the time of admission, and who live at the same address.
3. Children living in the catchment area.
4. Children without a Statement of Special Education Needs whose school placement has been identified by a multi-agency professional team.
5. Children living outside the catchment area, with an older sibling at the school at the time of admission, and who live at the same address.
6. Children living outside the catchment area, but nearest to the school and registered in a school which is part of the Ansford Federation (see note 1). (The measurement will be based on a straight-line distance from home to school using the LA's GIS mapping system).
7. Children outside the catchment area, not in a school which is part of the Ansford Federation, but nearest the school. (The measurement will be based on a straight-line distance from home to school using the LA's GIS mapping system).

The allocation of school places is arranged in line with the County Council's admissions policy. For more information contact the Pupil Placement Officer, County Hall on 0845 345 9166. The LA provides transport to the designated schools of the Federation and also to the nearest Secondary School (beyond 3 miles) if parents wish this.
